Paula Littlejohn, MHS, PhD, is currently a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the University of British Columbia and BC Children's Research Institute. She developed the first animal model to examine the impact of postnatal exposure to multiple micronutrient deficiencies on the gut microbiome and gut resistome. Presently her work focuses on understanding the role of maternal and postnatal nutrition in modulating epigenetic changes that have long-lasting effects.



B. Brett Finlay, OC, OBC, FRSC, FCAHS, is a Professor in the Michael Smith Laboratories and the Departments of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology and Microbiology and Immunology at the University of British Columbia. His research interests are focused on host-microbe interactions, at the molecular level. He has been at the forefront of the Cellular Microbiology field. His lab studies several pathogenic bacteria, including Salmonella and pathogenic E.coli and more recently microbiota.
